General Information

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success and you should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have too many stitches to stated tension, your tension is too tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is too loose and you should change to a smaller needle. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

Instructions given are for the 1st size, with larger sizes in brackets. Where only one figure or instruction is given, this applies to all sizes. Work all directions inside brackets to the number of times stated.

YARN

West Yorkshire Spinners - Bo Peep 4 Ply Splash Time (834) 1 [2:2:2:2:2:3] x 50g

MATERIALS

1 Pair 2.75mm (US 2/UK 12) knitting needles 1 Pair 3.25mm (US 3/UK 10) knitting needles Stitch holders 3 [4:4:4:5:5:5] Buttons

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm measured over st st, 28 sts and 41 rows to sleeve patt on larger needles or size needed to achieve stated tension.

VERY IMPORTANT - IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.



DESCRIPTION

A SIMPLE GARTER STITCH CARDIGAN WITH INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOTH BOYS AND GIRLS FASTENINGS.
SIZES PREMATURE (4 LBS) TO 12-18 MONTHS

BACK

Using 2.75mm needles cast on 50 [62:70:74:78:78:82] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: * P2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

These rows set rib.

Work 5 [5:5:5:7:7:7] rows in rib, ending with WS facing for next row.

Next row: Rib to end, inc 0 [0:1:1:0:1:1] st and dec 1 [1:0:0:1:0:0] st at end of row. 49 [61:71:75:77:79:83] sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont until work meas 9 [11:12:14:15:17:18]cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Next row: K2, sl1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Next row: P2, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, p2togtbl, p2. 45 [57:67:71:73:75:79] sts.

These 2 rows set armhole shaping.

Dec 1 st as set at each end of next 1 [1:3:3:3:3:3] rows, then on 2 foll RS rows. 39 [51:57:61:63:65:69] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole meas 8 [10:11:11:12:12:13]cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 4 [6:7:8:8:8:9] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off 4 [7:8:8:9:9:10] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 23 [25:27:29:29:31:31] sts.

Cast off rem 23 [25:27:29:29:31:31] sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 2.75mm needles cast on 23 [27:35:35:35:39:39] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2, rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 2: K1, * p2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

These 2 rows set rib.

Work 5 [5:5:7:7:7] rows in rib, ending with WS facing for next row.

Next row: Rib to end, inc 0 [1:0:0:1:0:0] st and dec 0 [0:2:0:0:2:0] sts across row. 23 [28:33:35:36:37:39] sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont until work meas 9 [11:12:14:15:17:18] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole and front neck

Next row: K2, sl1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Next row: Purl to last 4 sts, p2togtbl, p2. 20 [25:30:32:33:34:36] sts.

These 2 rows set armhole and neck shaping.

Dec 1 st as set at armhole edge of next 1 [1:3:3:3:3:3] rows, then on 2 foll RS rows and AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at neck edge as set on next and 2 [2:3:3:3:3:3] foll RS rows. 14 [19:21:23:24:25:27] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge as set on 2nd [4th:4th:2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd] and 4 [0:0:0:0:1:1] foll RS row, then on every foll 4th row to 8 [13:15:16:17:17:19] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Next row (RS): Cast off 4 [6:7:8:8:8:9] sts, knit to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 [7:8:8:9:9:10] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 2.75mm needles cast on 23 [27:35:35:35:39:39] sts.

Row 1 (RS): P1, * k2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: P2, * k2, p2, rep from * to last st, k1.

These 2 rows set rib.

Work 5 [5:5:5:7:7:7] rows in rib, ending with WS facing for next row.

Next row: Rib to end, inc 0 [1:0:0:1:0:0] st and dec 0 [0:2:0:0:2:0] sts across row. 23 [28:33:35:36:37:39] sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont until work meas 9 [11:12:14:15:17:18]cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole and front neck

Next row: K2, sl1, k1, psso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Next row: Purl to last 4 sts, p2togtbl, p2. 20 [25:30:32:33:34:36] sts.

These 2 rows set armhole and neck shaping.

Dec 1 st as set at armhole edge of next 1 [1:3:3:3:3:3] rows, then on 2 foll RS rows and AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at neck edge as set on next and 2 [2:3:3:3:3:3] foll RS rows. 14 [19:21:23:24:25:27] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge as set on 2nd [4th:4th:2nd:2nd:2nd:2nd] and 4 [0:0:0:0:1:1] foll RS row, then on every foll 4th row to 8 [13:15:16:17:17:19] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Next row (WS): Cast off 4 [6:7:8:8:8:9] sts, purl to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 4 [7:8:8:9:9:10] sts.

SLEEVES

Using 2.75mm needles cast on 30 [30:34:38:38:42:42] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: * P2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

These 2 rows set rib.

Work 3 [3:3:3:5:5:5] rows more in rib, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Next row: Rib to end, inc 0 [0:1:1:1:0:0] st at each end of row. 30 [30:36:40:40:42:42] sts.

Change to 3.25mm needles.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K1, m1 (by picking up loop between last and next st and working into the back of this loop), knit to last st, m1, k1. 32 [32:38:42:44:44] sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: (P1, m1p (by picking up loop between last and next st and working into the back of this loop purlwise) 1 [1:1:0:0:0:0] time, purl to last 1 [1:1:0:0:0:0] st, (m1p, p1) 1 [1:1:0:0:0:0] time. 34 [34:40:42:44:44] sts.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1. 36 [36:42:44:44:46:46] sts.

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: (P1, m1p) 0 [1:1:0:0:0:0] time, purl to last 0 [1:1:0:0:0:0] st, (m1p, p1) 0 [1:1:0:0:0:0] time. 36 [38:44:44:46:46] sts.

Row 10: Purl.

Row 11: K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1. 38 [40:46:46:46:48:48] sts.

Row 12: Purl.

These 12 rows set ridge patt and start sleeve shaping.

Inc 1 st as set at each end of 3rd [1st:3rd:3rd:3rd:3rd:3rd:3rd] row, 0 [3:0:2:5:1:2] foll - [RS:-:4th:4th:4th] rows, then on every foll 4th [4th:4th:6th:6th:6th] row to 42 [52:58:60:64:66:70] sts.

Cont without shaping until sleeve meas 8 [10:12:15:17:19:21]cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape sleeve top

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [3:5:5:5:5:5] rows, then on 2 foll RS rows. 32 [42:44:46:50:52:56] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off 4 [5:5:6:6:7:7] sts at beg of next 6 rows. 8 [12:14:10:14:10:14] sts.

Cast off rem 8 [12:14:10:14:10:14] sts.

MAKING UP

Using mattress stitch, join shoulder seams.

Borde

With RS facing, using 2.75mm needles, pick up and knit 29 [35:38:45:48:55:58] sts up right front edge to start of neck shaping, 26 [31:35:35:38:38:41] sts up right front neck, 22 [24:26:28:28:30:30] sts from back neck, 26 [31:35:35:38:38:41] sts down left front neck and 29 [35:38:45:48:55:58] sts down left front edge to cast on. 132 [156:172:188:200:216:228] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, * p2, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Row 2: K3, * p2, k2, rep from * to last st, k1.

These 2 rows set rib.

For a bov

Next row: Rib 3, (cast off 2 sts (1 st left on needle), rib 7 [6:7:9:9]) 2 [3:3:3:4:4:4] times, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.

For a girl

Next row: Rib to last 25 [32:35:41:45:53:53] sts, (cast off 2 sts (1 st left on needle), rib 7 [6:7:9:7:9:9]) 2 [3:3:3:4:4:4] times, cast off 2 sts (1 st left on needle), rib 2.

For both versions

Next row: Rib to end, casting on 2 sts over gaps created by casting off sts on previous row.

Work 3 rows in rib.

Cast off in rib.

loin side and sleeve seams.

Matching cast offs and decreases then easing rem fabric in to place, sew in sleeves.

Sew on buttons.
