# GENERAL INFORMATION

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## TENSION

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success and you should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have too many stitches to stated tension, your tension is too tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is too loose and you should change to a smaller needle. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

Instructions given are for the 1st Size, with larger sizes in brackets. Where only one figure or instruction is given, this applies to all sizes. Work all directions inside brackets to the number of times stated.

## WORKING FROM A CHART

When working from a chart you will read all right side rows from right to left and wrong side rows from left to right.

## FINISHING

Once your garment is completed it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for care instructions.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 188 x 61cm

## YARN

West Yorkshire Spinners - Signature 4 Ply

A Dusty Miller (129) 2 x 100g

B Cornflower (325) 1 x 100g

C Forget-Me-Not (801) 1 x 100g

## MATERIALS

3.75mm Needles

3.75mm Circular needles 100cm or longer

Cable needle

Stitch markers

## TENSION

25 sts and 35 rows to 10cm/4in over  
stocking stitch using 3.75mm needles



# TEXTURED SHAWL



## PATTERN NOTE

Colour sequence A, B and C repeated over stitch sections to centre then A, C and B repeated to end.

## FIRST HALF OF SHAWL

### Section 1 Moss Stitch

With 3.75mm needles and A, cast on 3 sts.

Purl 1 row.

**Next row (RS):** K1, p1, k1.

**Next row:** K1, p1, k1.

**Next row (inc):** K into the front and back of 1st st, then p1, k1. 4 sts.

**Next row:** (k1, p1) rep to end.

This sets moss st.

**Note:** the inc as set above will always be worked in the 1st st of every RS row but not included in the following section of instructions.

Work a further 51 rows in moss st, ending with WS facing for next row.

Purl 1 row. 30 sts.

Break off A and join in B.

## PATTERN NOTE

This shawl increases in the first stitch of every right side row. Where the pattern row in section 2 says Row 1: K1, LT, \* K4, RT, LT, rep from \* twice more.

You will work:

Row 1: Inc in first st, LT, \* K4, RT, LT, rep from \* twice more.

So row 3 you work:

Row 3: Inc in first st, K2, LT, \*K2, RT, K2, LT, rep from \* twice more.

Continue to inc in first st of every alt row counting the st increased in as the first stitch in the pattern. If it starts with K5, increase and K4.

Continue to increase in this manner.

## Section 2 Slip Stitch Lattice

Row 1: K1, LT, \* k4, RT, LT, rep from \* twice more, k3.

Row 2 and all even rows: P.

Row 3: K3, LT, \* k2, RT, k2, LT, rep from \* twice more, k2.

Row 5: K5, LT, \* RT, k4, LT, rep from \* twice more, k1.

Row 7: K7, \* RT, k6, rep from \* twice more, LT.

Row 9: K1, LT, \* k4, RT, LT, rep from \* twice more, k4, RT, k1.

Row 11: K3, LT, \* k2, RT, k2, LT, rep from \* twice more, k2, RT, k2.

Row 13: K5, LT, RT, \* k4, LT, RT, rep from \* twice more, k3.

Row 15: K.

Row 16: P. 38 sts.

Break off B and join in C.

## Section 3 Bobbles

Work 4 rows st st.

Row 5: K4, MB, \* k5, MB, rep from \* 4 more times, k5.

Row 6 and all even rows: P.

Row 7: K.

Row 9: K3, MB, \* k5, MB, rep from \* 5 more times, k2.

Row 11: As row 7.

Row 13: K2, MB, \* k5, MB, rep from \* 5 more times, k5.

Rows 14-16: As rows 6-8. 46 sts.

Break off C and join in A.

#### Section 4 Diagonal Rib

Row 1: K.

Row 2: \* P3, k3, rep from \* to last 5 sts, p3, k2.

Row 3: P3, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4 and all even rows: K all k sts and p all p sts.

Row 5: K2, p3, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 7: P1, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to end.

Row 9: P3, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last 5 sts, k3, p2.

Row 11: K2, \* p3, k3, rep from \* to last st, p1.

Row 13: P1, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 14: K all k sts and p all p sts.

Rows 3 to 14 set direction of rib.

Cont in patt as set taking extra sts into rib.

Work a further 41 rows.

Row 56: P. 74 sts.

Break off A and join in B.

#### Section 5 Trinity Stitch

Row 1: K.

Row 2: K.

Row 3: P.

Row 4: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 17 times more, k2.

Row 5 and all odd numbered rows: P.

Row 6: K2, \* p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, rep from \* 17 times more, k3.

Row 8: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 17 times more, k4.

Row 10: K2, \* p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, rep from \* 17 times more, k5.

Row 12: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 18 times more, k2.

Row 14: K2, \* p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, rep from \* 18 times more, k3.

Row 15: P.

Row 16: K. 82 sts.

Break off B and join in C.

#### Section 6 Double Moss Stitch

Row 1: K.

Row 2: \* K1, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 3: K1, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to end.

Row 4: \* P1, k1, rep from \* to end.

Row 5: K1, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to last st, p1.

Row 6: \* K1, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Last 4 rows set double moss st.

Work a further 9 rows. 90 sts.

Row 16: P.

Break off C and join in A.

#### Section 7 Cats Paw Stitch

Row 1: K.

Row 2: P.

Row 3: K5, yo, ssk, \* k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, rep from \* 7 more times, k4.

Row 4 and all even rows: P.

Row 5: K2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, \* k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, rep from \* 7 more times, k3.

Row 7: K5, yo, k3togtbl, yo, \* k7, yo, k3togtbl, yo, rep from \* 7 more times, k5.

Row 9: K3, yo, ssk, \* k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, rep from \* 7 more times, k9.

Row 11: K5, yo, ssk, \* k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, rep from \* 7 more times, k3, k2tog, yo, k3.

Row 13: K3, yo, k3togtbl, yo, \* k7, yo, k3togtbl, yo, rep from \* 7 more times, k10.

Row 14: P.

Last 12 rows set cats paw placement. Take extra sts into patt as appropriate, with the exception of the last 3 sts at the end of every RS row which are knitted in st st. Work in patt for a further 36 rows.

Row 51: K.

Row 52: P. 116 sts.

Break off A and join in B.

#### Section 8 Bells

Row 1: P2, k4, \* p1, TP2, p1, k4, rep from \* 12 more times, p1, TP2, p3.

Row 2: K6, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 12 more times, p4, k3.

Row 3: P3, k4, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 12 more times, p6.

Row 4 and 6: K and p all sts as set.

Row 5: \* p4, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p6.

Row 7: P1, \* p4, TL1, TR1, rep from \* 13 more times, p6.

Row 8: K6, \* k1, p2, k5, rep from \* 13 more times, k2.

Row 9: P2, k4, \* p1, TP2, p1, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p2.  
Rows 10: K2, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p4, k3.  
Row 11: P3, k4, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p2.  
Rows 12: K and p all sts as set.  
Row 13: P4, \* TL1, TR1, p4, rep from \* 13 more times, TL1, TR1, p2.  
Row 14: K3, p2, k1, \* k5, p2, k1, rep from \* 13 more times, k5.  
Row 15: P6, TP2, \* p6, TP2, rep from \* 13 more times, p3. 124 sts.  
Row 16: K.

Break off B and join in C.

### Section 9 Hearts

Row 1: K.

Row 2 and all even rows: P.

Row 3: K8, \* k2tog, yo, k10, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k7.

Row 5: K8, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k7, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5.

Row 7: K8, \* k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k5, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4.

Row 9: K3, yo, ssk, k3, \* k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k3, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k3.

Row 11: K5, yo, ssk, k1, \* k2tog, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2.

Row 13: K3, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k5, \* yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k5, rep from \* 8 more times, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k4.

Row 14: P.

Row 15: K.

Row 16: P. 132 sts.

Break off C and join in A.

### Section 10 Cables

Row 1: P2, \* k6, p4, rep from \* 12 more times.

Row 2: \* K4, p6, rep from \* 12 more times, k3.

Rows 3-6: As rows 1 and 2 taking extra sts into patt.

Row 7: K1, \* P4, C6F, rep from \* to last 4 sts, p4.

These 7 rows set cable and rev st st placement. Work C6F as set on next 7 foll 6th rows, then work 7 rows without working C6F. 160 sts.

Place a marker on the last st of the last row - this is the triangle centre line of the shawl.

Now work 2nd half of shawl, dec instead of inc and working the patt in reverse of 1st half starting with section 10 cables as follows:-

## 2ND HALF OF SHAWL

### Section 10 Cables

Row 1: \* K6, p4, rep from \* 15 more times.

Row 2: \* K4, p6, rep from \* 15 more times.

Row 3 (dec): Ssk, k4, p4, \* k6, p4, rep from \* 14 more times. 159 sts.

Note: the dec as set above will always be worked in the first 2 sts of every RS row but not included in the following section of instructions.

Row 4: \* K4, p6, rep from \* 14 more times, k4, p5.

Row 5: K5, p4, \* k6, p4, rep from \* 14 more times.

Row 6: \* K4, p6, rep from \* 14 more times, k4, p4.

Row 7: K4, p4, \* k6, p4, rep from \* 14 more times.

Row 8: \* K4, p6, rep from \* 14 more times, k4, p3.

Row 9: K3, p4, \* C6B, p4, rep from \* 14 more times.

Last 7 rows set cable and rev st st placement. Work C6B as set on next 7 foll 6th rows, then work 5 rows without working C6B. 133 sts.

Break off A and join in C.

### Section 9 Hearts

Row 1: K.

Row 2 and all even rows: P.

Row 3: K3, \* k2tog, yo, k10, rep from \* 9 more times, k2tog, yo, k7.

Row 5: K4, yo, ssk, k7, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k7, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5.

Row 7: K4, yo, ssk, k5, \* k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k5, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k4.

Row 9: K4, yo, ssk, k3, \* k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k3, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk, k3.

Row 11: K4, yo, ssk, k1, \* k2tog, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, rep from \* 8 more times, k2tog, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2.

Row 13: K8, \* yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k5, rep from \* 8 more times, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k1, yo, sl 1k, k2tog, pssso, yo, k4.

Row 14: P.

Row 15: K. 125 sts.

Break off C and join in B.

Row 16: P.

### Section 8 Bells

Row 1: P3, k4, \* p1, TP2, p1, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p1, TP2, p3.

Row 2: K6, \* p4, k4, rep from \* to last 6 sts, p4, k2.

Row 3: P2, k4, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p6.

Row 4 and 6: K and p all sts as set.

Row 5: P1, k4, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p6.

Row 7: K4, \* p4, TL1, TR1, rep from \* 13 more times, p6.

Row 8: K6, \* k1, p2, k5, rep from \* 13 more times, k1, p2, k2.

Row 9: P3, k4, \* p1, TP2, p1, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p2.

Rows 10: K2, \* p4, k4, rep from \* 13 more times, p4.

Row 11: P2, \* k4, p4, rep from \* 13 more times, k4, p2.

Row 12: K and p all sts as set.

Row 13: K5, \* p4, TL1, TR1, rep from \* 13 more times, p2.

Row 14: K2, \* k1, p2, k5, rep from \* 13 more times, p4.

Row 15: P3 \* p6, TP2, rep from \* 13 more times, p3.

Row 16: K. 117 sts.

Break off B, join in A.

### Section 7 Cats Paw Stitch

Row 1: K.

Row 2 and all even rows: P.

Row 3: K7, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, rep from \* 9 more times, k4.

Row 5: K5, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, \* k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, rep from \* 9 more times, k3.

Row 7: K6, yo, k3togtbl, yo, \* k7, yo, k3togtbl, yo, rep from \* 9 more times, k5.

Row 9: K4, \* k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, rep from \* 9 more times, k9.

Row 11: K4, \* k3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, rep from \* 9 more times, k3, k2tog, yo, k3.

Row 13: K8, yo, k3togtbl, yo, \* k7, yo, k3togtbl, yo, rep from \* 8 more times, k10.

Row 14: P.

Last 12 rows set cats paw placement.

Work in patt for a further 36 rows.

Row 51: K.

Row 52: P. 91 sts.

Break off A and join in C.

### Section 6 Double Moss Stitch

Row 1: K.

Row 2: \* K1, p1, rep from \* to end.

Row 3: \* P1, k1, rep from \* to end.

Row 4: \* P1, k1, rep from \* to last st, p1.

Row 5: \* P1, k1, rep from \* to last st, p1.

Row 6: \* K1, p1, rep from \* to end.

Last 4 rows set double moss st.

Work a further 9 rows. 83 sts.

Row 16: P.

Break off C, join in B.

### Section 5 Trinity Stitch

Row 1: K.

Row 2: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 18 more times, k4.

Row 3 and all odd numbered rows: P.

Row 4: K2, \* p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, rep from \* 18 more times, k3.

Row 6: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 18 more times, k2.

Row 8: K2, \* p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, rep from \* 17 more times, k5.

Row 10: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 17 more times, k4.

Row 12: K2, \* p3tog, (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, rep from \* 17 more times, k3.

Row 14: K2, \* (k1, p1, k1) all in next st, p3tog, rep from \* 17 more times, k2.

Row 15: P.

Row 16: K. 75 sts.

Break off B and join in A.

### Section 4 Diagonal Rib

Row 1: K.

Row 2: \* K3, p3, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: P1, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 4 and all even rows: K all k sts and p all p sts.

Row 5: K2, p3, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 7: P3, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to end.

Row 9: P1, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to last 4 sts, k3, p1.

Row 11: K2, \* p3, k3, rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 13: P3, \* k3, p3, rep from \* to end.

Row 14: K all k sts and p all p sts.

Rows 3 to 14 sets direction of rib. Cont in patt as set.

Work a further 41 rows.

Row 56: P. 47 sts.

Break off A and join in C.

### Section 3 Bobbles

Work 4 rows st st.

Row 5: K3, MB, \* k5, MB, rep from \* 5 more times, k5.

Row 6 and all even rows: P.

Row 7: K.

Row 9: K4, MB, \* k5, MB, rep from \* 5 more times, k2.

Row 11: As row 7.

Row 13: K5, MB, \* k5, MB, rep from \* 4 more times, k5.

Rows 14 and 15: As rows 6 and 7. 39 sts.

Break off C and join in B.

Row 16: P.

### Section 2 Slip st lattice

Row 1: K4, \* k4, RT, LT, rep from \* 3 more times, k3.

Row 2 and all even rows: P.

Row 3: K4, \* k2, RT, k2, LT, rep from \* 3 more times, k2.

Row 5: K4, \* RT, k4, LT, rep from \* 3 more times, k1.

Row 7: K4, \* k6, RT, rep from \* twice more, k8.

Row 9: K4, \* k4, RT, LT, rep from \* twice more, k4, RT, k1.

Row 11: K4, \* k2, RT, k2, LT, rep from \* twice more, k2, RT, k2.

Row 13: K4, RT, \* k4, LT, RT, rep from \* twice more, k3.

Row 15: K. 31 sts.

Break off B and join in A.

Row 16: P.

### Section 1 Moss st

Next row: \* K1, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

This sets moss st.

Work a further 54 rows in moss st, ending with WS facing for next row.

P 1 row. 3 sts.

Cast off rem 3 sts.

### Top Edging

With 3.75mm circular needle and B, starting at RH end and with RS facing, pick up and knit 466 sts evenly.

Work 2 rows g st. Cast off kwise.

### Bottom Edging

With 3.75mm circular needle and B, beg at end of right hand slope and with RS facing, pick up and knit 5 sts at the cast on edge, 255 sts to the centre marked st, pick up and knit this st, 255 sts along the second slope and 5 sts at the cast off end. 521 sts.

Next row (WS): K4, k into front, back and front of next st, k to 1 st before centre marker, k this st, k into the front and back of the next st, k to the last 5 sts, k into the front, back and front of the next st, k4.

Next row: K.

Cast off all sts kwise

### MAKING UP

Sew in all ends. Block knitting out to the dimensions given.

See ball band for care instructions.
